P – 1 BE IT RESOVLED that Keri DeLalio is appointed to a three (3) year probationary term from July 14, 2014 through July 13, 2017 in the position of Director of Pupil Services; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the President of the Board of Education is authorized to execute an Employment Agreement, dated July 7, 2014. The salary shall be \$110,000, prorated bi weekly, plus benefits.

P – 2 BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education hereby approves the appointment of Sarah Dunkirk to a .5 English as a Second Language Teacher and a .5 Reading Teacher effective September 2, 2014. The salary shall be \$58,006, MA Step 2, prorated bi weekly, plus benefits.

PROPOSED POLICY ON CHILDREN OF NON-RESIDENT STAFF MEMBERS

Children of full-time instructional staff who are not residents of the Springs Union Free School District may attend District schools on a tuition-free basis. Application for enrollment must be made to the Superintendent of Schools in the form of a written letter. Approval is not automatic. A non-resident student of a full-time instructional staff member will not be approved if acceptance of that student's admission will create the need to employ additional staff, or cause class size to increase beyond what is desirable as per the discretion of the District, or will create stress on the use of facilities in the District, or is currently serving a period of suspension or expulsion from the home district. The non-resident student of the full-time instructional staff member shall meet all academic and behavioral standards of the District and the student's continued attendance in the District is conditioned upon meeting these standards. The full-time instructional staff member shall assume complete responsibility for the transportation of the student to the District.
